April 2012: **Japan and Okinawa**. As always the yearly visit in Japan and Okinawa is a kind of high light for me as a professional Martial Artist.

I spent the first week in Kyoto as participant of the 50th All Japan Dai Nippon Butoku Kai's Butokusai held at the historic Butokuden, the oldest Martial Art Dojo (training hall) of Japan.

Dai Nippon Butokukai (DNBK) is a historic, elite society for the most senior classical Budo Teachers, existing since the XVII. Century, under the wings of the Emperor's wing, as the only official and governmental Budo society. The Dai Nippon Butokukai is the professional entity that awarded the ranks of all the famous style creators of the modern Martial Arts, just to mention a few: Kano of Judo, Ueshiba of Aikido, Miyagi, Funakoshi and Konishiki of Karate Do.

Every four years the DNBK organises a huge gathering of Japan's best Masters of the various Martial Arts together with selected international Teachers of the Art. It is always a very exciting and unique experience to train, exercise and demonstrate at the historic Butokuden, under the watchful eyes of the best of the bests.

This time I was accompanied by two of my South African students: Sensei Mario Sequiera and Che Jagger both 5th Dan from our Johannesburg Dojo. We trained and demonstrated our art every day of our hectic week. **At the last day of the event, Dai Nippon Butokukai bestowed upon myself the highest possible Teachers title, HANSHI!** This is the most outstanding honour to be the 7th non Japanese to achieve this rank, since the existence of the Dai Nippon Butokukai.

The second week we moved to Okinawa, to the birth place of Karate Do, to our home Dojo the world famous, historic Jundokan Dojo the base of Okinawa Goju Ryu. This is our professional umbrella in the last 35 years. We spent a whole week training with our Friends and Seniors daily 4-6 hours, excellent quality time and lovely training and exchanging of experience with the best of the bests.

Beside all these International activities IBSSA-ISF hosted professional meetings and courses at its HQ in Israel, with some of the outstanding leaders of IBSSA-ISF and close friends:
