8-12 May 1999 there were several meetings held in Geneva with the participation of the above officials.

The minutes of the Open IBSSA Education and Qualification

Department Meeting and the minutes of the Board Meeting are enclosed.

After 3 days hard work on the 11th May 99 an Open Meeting was held with the involvement of all present IBSSA members in the Headquarters Hotel.

The meeting was opened by George Popper-Executive President who gave a report about the activities and work done by the leadership since the last Congress held November 1998 in Budapest. He also reported the very successful meeting which was held just 3 weeks ago in Tel Aviv Israel. Minutes of that meeting are available on the Internet.

The new IBSSA Magazine with the Congress Minutes and an IBSSA CD ROM was distributed.

Dr. Rony Kluger-General Secretary gave an Information and distributed the draft of the document elaborated by the Education and Qualification Department. After some proposals the rules were finalized.

After lunch brake Mr. Zeev Gefen, the President of the Israeli College for Security and Investigation gave an information about the structure and the education system of his College.

As an interesting case he gave a very professional lecture about the "Rabin assassination"

Mr. Popper reported, that Mr. Marko Nicovic Vice President (Yugoslavia) visited the HQ last week and excused himself because he was not able to attend the Board Meeting. The president gave an actual Information about the ongoing war in Yugoslavia.

Adi Popper, who is in charge for IBSSA Internet site informed that member companies, as it was decided by the last congress will have a free 2 page information on IBSSA WEB Site.

Individual members for a yearly us\$ 50.- charge can have that information as well. It is also possible, that for a yearly 50.-\$ IBSSA members will have an own IBSSA E-mail number.(for instance: pop@ibssa.org) He again draw the attention, that new Information about IBSSA you can find at.

All delegates visited the CEFAS training center. Mr. Salvisberg gave an information about the training facilities and their system. He explained that beside the Training center in Geneva since two years they have a base at France too. CEFAS was one of the first IBSSA recognized training centers and their licenses are accepted by the European Community.

Mr. Bertoletti, Rony Kluger and Julian Moisescu performed a short but very professional self defense demonstration for the students and instructors of the CEFAS Training Center.

The President thanked the hospitality, than accompanied by the present Board Members he gave over the first official IBSSA Diplomas for certified instructors and teachers.

After a small cocktail-party given by Mr. Salvisberg all official programs were closed.
