## **IBSSA International Special Security Training Course**

The IBSSA Headquarters organised an International Special Security Training Course between 10-14 September 2003 in Budapest / Hungary with the support of the Hungarian Police Academy and the Adyliget Law Enforcement College. Besides numerous IBSSA leaders and chief instructors from all over the world, who were present at this professional event, many qualified bodyguards, Master Teachers and even Instructors of the Special Unit of the Hungarian Army, and police officers participated at the training from Hungary, Italy, Slovenia, Northern Ireland, Singapore, Bosnia-Herzegovina, Romania and France.

2. Before the 10<sup>th</sup> IBSSA Congress, which will be held in Hurghada / EGYPT in November 2004, an Open Board Meeting with preparatory discussions to the congress will be organised in February 2004 in Hurghada together with diving and bodyguard training courses.
