Dr. Bertoletti reported that the Italian Ministry of Home Affairs and all necessary Authorities – inclusive the Regional Government agreed to hold the IBSSA Congress in Italy.

There for it was finally confirmed, that the 6th Congress will be held on 16-19 March 2000 at Caorle/Venice Italy.

It was agreed, that parallel with the IBSSA Congress the first IBSSA International Sport Championships would be held which organized by the IBSSA International Sport Federation (Karate, Jujitsu and other sports).

It was again stated, that the membership cards for 2000 would be distributed in January only for those members, who paid membership fee for 2000.

It was decided, that the long term IBSSA training program will be published in January 2000 on the Internet.

This program will contain the fixed and coordinated training seminars for five years period 6-8 courses yearly at least.

Mr. Florentin Marinescu, President of IBSSA Europe and Master Teacher agreed to lead the IBSSA -Graddo a.s. Training Center in Czech Republic and he will be in charge for the preparations of the 1st IBSSA Bodyguard Championships.

Very successful training courses were organized in November-December 1999 in Israel Italy, Romania, and Hungary. Numerous international and national TV channels reported on the events.

IBSSA Macedonia requested the HQ for the organization of a Bodyguard Course in Skopje early 2000.

The Kosova Karate Federation with the support of their Government applied for IBSSA membership.

Mr. John Dora, Honorary member of Great Britain visited Hungary and had a meeting with the Executive President and Mr. Levente Gyenes, Country Representative of IBSSA Hungary.
